BCC Co-Sponsors Deaf Community Conference - BCC recently collaborated with the Deaf Counseling, Advocacy & Referral Agency (DCARA) to host Deaf Community: Through the Lens of Social Justice here at the BCC Campus. The two-day, sold out event was the largest ever hosted by DCARA and BCC's own Dr. Jenny Gough served as co-lead in organizing the event. Carla Garcia Fernandez served as the keynote speaker for the conference. Garcia Fernandez is the co-founder of Teachers for Social Justice: Deaf Learners Organization. The weekend featured discussions on transforming social justice and community accountability in the Deaf community.



Umoja Students Attend AMEND Conference - Berkeley City College's Umoja students recently attended the 10th Annual African American Male Education Network Development (AMEND) summit in Los Angeles. AMEND seeks to use its scholarly and professional expertise to foster institutional change within the community college system. The two-day event hosted over 1,000 male students, college administrators, faculty and support staff. Thirty African American young men including several from the Peralta College District, received \$47,000 in scholarships to attend community colleges and four year institutions. This year's conference featured author, radio host and Georgetown University Professor and Dr. Michael Eric Dyson, author and Morehouse College professor Dr. Mark Lamont Hill.

CAP Conference Coming to BCC - BCC is again hosting an all-day workshop for Northern California Community College statistics instructors on Saturday, April 1st. "I Would Be Embarrassed If My Statistics Students Didn't Know..." will be held here as part of the California Acceleration Project (CAP) workshops during Spring 2017. The purpose of the workshop is to deepen statistical understanding and introduce best practices in pedagogy related to the teaching of introductory statistics at the community college level. This year, the workshop will be led by Dr. Roxy Peck, a pioneer and international leader in the field of statistics education. Discussion topics include statistical literacy as well as the meanings of "confidence" and "error" in the subject of statistics. An advanced level session will introduce participants to an alternative method for finding confidence intervals based on creating a "bootstrap distribution." Organizers recommend bringing a laptop to the workshop scheduled for Saturday, April 1, 2017 from 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. at BCC.
