VII. DISCUSSION ITEMS

(5:00 min)

A. Read over the Descriptions of Office Positions of the Associated Students of Berkeley City College in the Constitution - Hassan Moore

Officer page is available online. Description of board members is very detailed and everyone should look over their duties.
Sen. Nate Heller asks if it is part of our constitution

B. Senator adopts a bulletin board- Justin Terry

VP of programs Justin Terry notes that the bulletin boards need to be cleaned. Senators volunteer to clean bulletin boards once a week. (VP Thays Da Costa arrives 12:12PM)

Advisor Mostafa agrees that the bulletin boards should be cleaned up. ASBCC is responsible for regulating the boards and making sure all flyers are up to date and organized.

President Valentino Calderon asks how to appoint which senators will be elected to regulate bulletin boards, also was under the impression that bulletin board regulation is part of ambassador's duties.

VP of programs Justin Terry replies that ASBCC can help and that we are actually in charge of bulletin boards.
(Sen. Miles Campbell and Justice Official Lanfu Zhang arrive 12:15PM)

C. Extension of Constitutional Code of Conduct (Article 7) to the Officership of Clubs-Hassan Moore

Chief Justice Hassan Moore points out that there is an informal form of conduct of behavior for ASBCC. He feels that since clubs and club leadership is connected to ASBCC these informal forms of conducts should also be upheld by clubs and their leaders.

VP of programs Justin Terry suggests Chief Justice Hassan Moore to join him in looking over the ICC charter. He agrees that there should be the same standard.

Public member Donna Ayo would like to make sure that this is included in ICC charter and bylaws.

President Valentino Calderon passes his chair to VP Thays Da Costa.

D. Discussion regarding the purpose of the Peralta Student Council, the issues which currently face that body, and consideration of several possible actions that ASBCC might take in support of its future-Valentino Calderon, Nate Heller, Hassan Moore

President Valentino Calderon says ASBCC members can join committee to help outline the purpose of Peralta Student Council.

Sen. Nate Heller wants to move the question of how to establish the body of Peralta Student Council. The Associated Students of Alameda members and trustees are in a meeting to discuss what this means to the college in relevance to the trustee. There is room to re-write and re-vote on this.

VP Thays Da Costa says this is a great idea but she doesn't believe this is relevant at this point. Focus should be on the purpose of the PSC. It has been noted that there has been conflict among members of the PSC, there should not be any problems—if there are it should be discussed one on one.

Associated Students of Alameda voted no confidence and VP of programs Justin Terry is shocked our colleagues would do this.

President Valentino Calderon would like to propose how to outline this for future meetings.

Chief Justice Hassan Moore believes the mission of PSC is what we need, and that these issues that have arisen have eroded that mission vision.

Sen. Nate Heller motions to extend discussion time to an extra 5 minutes.

Treasurer Malik Elhindi believes this matter should be delegated to ambassadors and that they would be fit to facilitate this. They know a lot about financial aid and whatever is occurring on campus.

Sen. Nate Heller says that there are three meetings that are already occurring regarding this matter.
