



## **Faculty Advising Taskforce**

### **Charge for Spring 2015:**

Develop a faculty-advising model that will help students

- 1) explore life and career goals,
- 2) explore BCC programs,
- 3) enter a program of study,
- 4) complete a certificate/degree/transfer and
- 5) transition into their next phase of life.

The faculty-advising model will consist of two phases of faculty advising:

- General Advising for students who are exploring and learning about the college and programs AND
- Major Advising for students who have made a decision to enter a program of study and are exploring within that field of study.

### **Commitment:**

- Attend two scheduled meetings per month starting in February on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesdays from 12:15-1:30.
- One Saturday meeting in April/May from 9-1 (to be determined)
- Participation in conducting/leading student focus groups to identify what students need/want from faculty advising.
- Participation in additional subgroups to develop:
  1. Program fact sheets
  2. Program elements: workshops, events, etc.
  3. Faculty Advisor roles, obligations and deliverables
  4. Faculty Advisor training model
  5. Faculty Advisor application and screening process
  6. Student outreach and recruitment

Faculty recruitment/application - April

Faculty training - May

Faculty Advising Kick-off - August

Implementation in Fall 2015.
