V. NEW BUSINESS

A. SSCCC General Assembly Funding (John Nguyen | Discussion & Action | 10 Min)

- a. The ASBCC council will vote whether to fund further council participation at the SSCCC General Assembly.
- b. Advisor Nguyen forwards questions to AS about attending the conference.
- c. President Zhu mentions that Serigo can attend because he is a delegate, or, alternatively, the ASBCC can attend.
- d. Senator Mazariegos Motions to fund. VP Li Seconds.
- e. Senator Mazariegos and Advisor Nguyen emphasize that this is a good opportunity to network and make connections.
- f. Motion passes 10-0-0.
- g. President Zhu introduces a topic about ASBCC involvement, and how many members are not able to prioritize this commitment.
- h. VP Bui mentions that he met with President Zhu and Chief Justice Sciaroni about involvement and systemic concerns. Also talks about how students are worried about the ASBCC's commitment to key issues (AC Transit, Honorlock). VP Bui hopes that, by the end of this semester, bigger projects will be accomplished. There are issues about motivating students to invest time in Student Government matters after applying as well.
- i. President Zhu urges AS members to turn on cameras to increase engagement, and work towards leaving a legacy.
- j. Senator Mazariegos forwards a discussion about habits and appreciating opportunities.
- k. Senator Bui talks about self growth, and how learning from AS experience allows an individual to impact other communities.

- 1. Advisor Nguyen echoes Senator Mazariegos comments, and mentions that Student opportunity can teach you many helpful skills.
- m. President Zhu mentions that there needs to be more involvement in committees. VP Bui also remarks that doing the bare minimum is not serving students.
- n. Senator Ahazie surfaces the topic of workload on working, full time, students.
- o. Senator Kopti mentions that there is a loss of connection, partly because AS members are unable to meet in person. There should be more communication among members, and AS members are servants to the student population.
- p. VP Ahazie encourages members to communicate and establish connections among Student Government members.

B. AC Transit Information (President Zhu | Discussion | 15 Min)

- a. The ASBCC council will discuss next steps for the AC Transit referendum addition to the ballot.
- b. Chief Justice Sciaroni talks about meeting with VC Brown, and how many matters were rushed and handled poorly. Communication was not ideal between students and faculty.
- c. Advisor Nguyen offers to communicate these thoughts about election times.
- d. VP Bui talks about a special election, but there are questions about pursuing this discussion this semester, or next semester.
- e. Chief Justice Sciaroni mentions that it is not feasible to move the election back, but it would be beneficial for the next administration to have this information.
- f. Senator Kopti asks a question about priority for this topic, because campus will not open next Fall.
- g. VP Bui motions to extend the meeting by 10 min. Senator Kopti Seconds. Vote Passes 10-0-0
