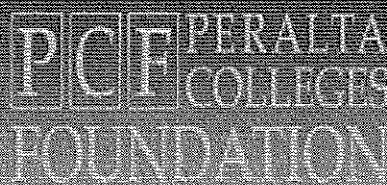
SUBJECT: Scholarships/Awards for 2009-2010
