# (Student Copy) Berkeley City College Cross Enrollment Program

The Cross Enrollment Program (SB 1914) allows undergraduate students who meet certain eligibility criteria and are enrolled at any California Community College, the California State University, or the University of California to enroll, without formal admission in any of the other systems. BCC also offers a Cross Enrollment program with SF State, and Cal State East Bay.

#### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Must have completed at least one semester at Berkeley City College as a matriculated student.
- > Enrolled in at least 6 units at Berkeley City College during the current semester.
- > The student must pay the appropriate tuition required by Berkeley City College for the semester
- ➤ Earned a grade point average of 2.0 and have the appropriate academic preparation, as determined by the host campus, consistent with the standard applied to currently enrolled students, i.e., completion of pre-requisites and or assessment using multiple measures.
- Admission to the course is subject to availability and instructor approval.
- > Students may not take more than 12 units in total for Cross Enrollment.
- > Students may only enroll in lower division courses (0-99)
- Student may not enroll in a course that is offered through Peralta.

#### **Enrollment Conditions:**

- 1. Approval for Cross Enrollment is valid for the current term only & students must re-apply every term.
- 2. Students that have attended previous educational institutions must provide an unofficial copy of all coursework completed at that institution and at all Peralta Campuses.
- 3. Records of credit earned through Cross-Enrollment are maintained by the University of California, Berkeley (UCB) which is the host campus. Students must request a transcript be sent to Berkeley City College, Admissions and Records Department. Your UCB Grade will NOT AUTOMATICALLY APPEAR on YOUR BCC TRANSCRIPTS. PERALTA ADMISSIONS AND RECORDS DETERMINE IF UCB COURSEWORK WILL BE ACCEPTED AS A TRANSFER CREDIT OR if that course work may be used toward degree requirements.
- 4. Students are responsible for paying UCB \$46 per unit and any additional fees required for UCB students (lab materials, computer access, and text book and or reference items). You will complete this task with D'Nean the UCB Cross-Enrollment liaison.
- 5. Information concerning identification card policies, library, and other facilities usage should be obtained during registration at the host campus (UCB).
- 6. Students are subject to all administrative procedures and rules established by Berkeley City College which is the home campus.

### **Final Steps for Approval:**

- 1. The deadline for Spring 2022 semester application is Friday, December 3<sup>rd</sup> 2021. Any applications turned in after the deadline are approved on a case by case basis and subject to the final approval of The Cross Enrollment Coordinator.
- 2. Students will be notified of their pre-acceptance into the Program by Wednesday, December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021 (vis email) and must attend a mandatory on-line Orientation which are scheduled for Tuesday, December 14<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, December 15th. Submission of final grades for Fall 2021 enrollment verification are required for final acceptance in Cross Enrollment Program.
