<b>IV. Standardizing Program Language for the Catalog</b>		J. Lowood, J. Bielanski, and A. Tomas will be meeting to draft a standardized language to describe programs for the catalog.
<b>V. Course Grading Options</b>	Currently, the PROMT system can only keep one grading option for a course that is offered at multiple colleges within our District even if one college has a "Letter Grade Only" option and another colleges has "Both letter grade or for pass/no pass" options. This causes confusion when scheduling course, as the schedulers would have to keep track of the grading options for courses and manually override the system when there is a mistake. Several factors are considered when assigning a grading option for a course: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Student needs to earn a letter grade for courses that are part of</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	

	<p>the “Golden Four” GE areas.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Students can only transfer with a certain amount of units that were earned with a P/NP.</li> <li>○ Students sometimes prefer to take a course as P/NP if they know they will struggle with the course.</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● If it is a system issue, the District IT Department should be informed.</li> </ul>
