The following were discussed: <ul> <li>There are several new Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADTs) in the department, and they are working on marketing these programs to students.</li> <li>The department is working with Stephanie Sanders-Badt, coordinator of Public and Human Services program, to streamline their program offerings. It was suggested that the program move to being transfer-focused.</li> <li>One of the department's goals is to develop a two year schedule, with some flexibility.</li> <li>The department is also working on creating Ethnic Studies Certificate of Proficiency. It was suggested that the department consider creating a low-unit Certificate of Achievement, instead of a Certificate of Proficiency.</li> <li>The department is also working with the Arts and Cultural Studies Department in revising the Women's Studies Certificate of Proficiency, which will become Gender Studies.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
