Canvas Transition

Fall 2017 marks a pilot semester for our transition to the Learning Management System Canvas. Here are some highlights of the transition:

- Six trained faculty volunteered to pilot their courses in Canvas this fall
- Peralta set up the website **learn.peralta.edu** to host Canvas
- Peralta has committed to increased technical support for Canvas including 24/7 phone support

What to expect this fall:

- All faculty will have access to Canvas sandboxes to prepare for spring courses
- Training and technical support for the transition
- College hour opportunities to review and discuss implementation of the OEI Course Design Rubric

- Moodle will continue to be available to support classes
- Instructors teaching online or hybrid courses in Spring '18 will be using Canvas for Spring '18 classes
- Instructors using Moodle to support face-to-face courses may switch to Canvas in Spring '18 or continue supporting their courses with Moodle through Fall '18
