# Statewide Zero Textbook Cost Program - Background

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In 2021, the California Legislature appropriated \$115 million for the CCCs [Zero Textbook Cost Program](#)



Goals: “reduce the overall cost of education for students and decrease the time it takes students to complete degree programs offered by community colleges”

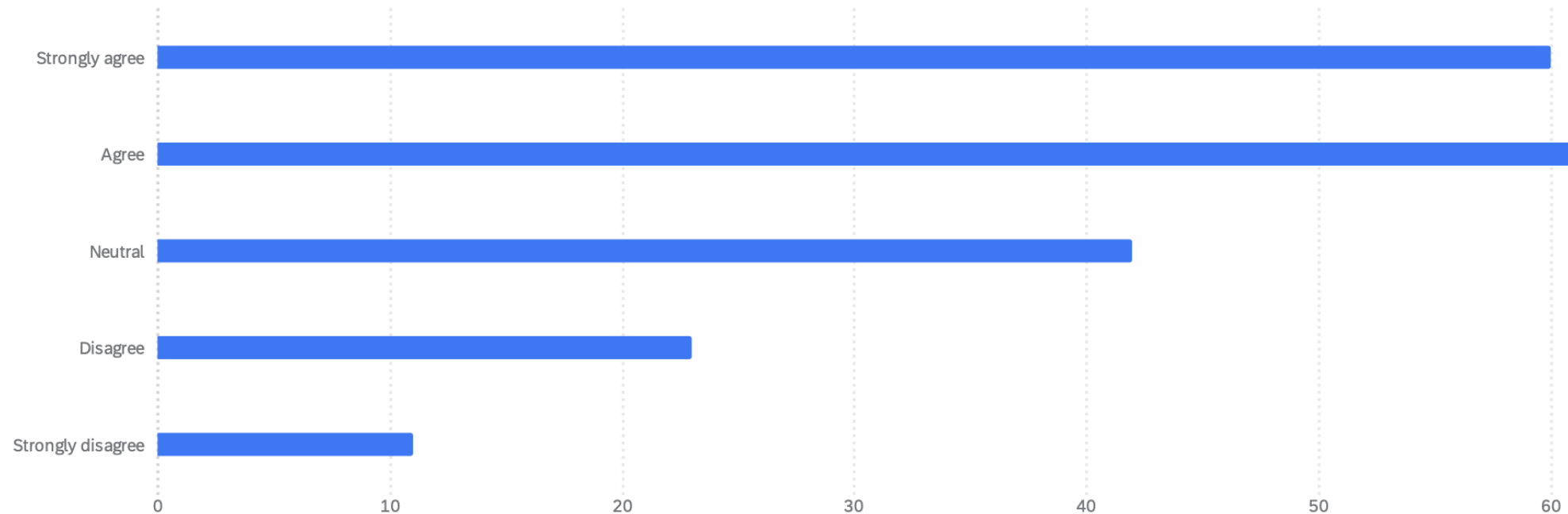


BCC received \$640k through apportionment and applying for grants

# Student survey – Spring 2025

Over half of respondents (62%, 124 out of 200 total) agreed with the statement: “The cost of course materials has influenced my enrollment decisions.”

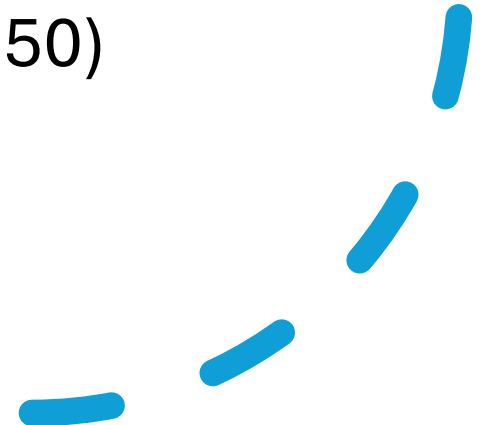
3. Please choose your level of agreement with this statement: The cost of course materials has influenced my decision to enroll in a class. 200 ⓘ



# Student responses to high course material costs:

Has the high cost of course materials ever resulted in ...

- **Not purchasing required course materials: 53% (N=105)**
- Dropping a class: 26% (N=52)
- Changing majors: 11% (N=21)
- **Taking fewer classes: 31% (N=61)**
- Getting a lower grade: 25% (N=50)

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## Progress on ZTC courses – Fall 2025

- 40 percent of lectures & labs at BCC were ZTC in Fall 2025

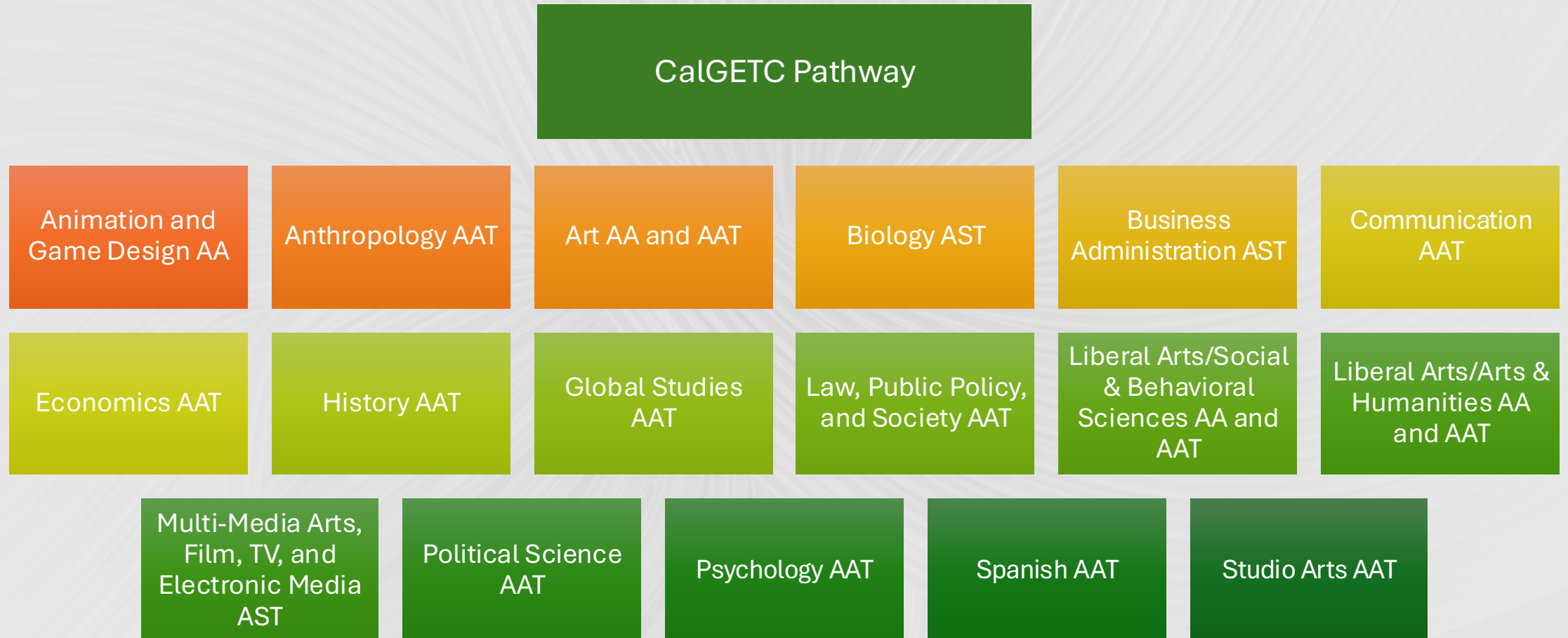
