#### AANAPISI

- Asian American Native American Pacific Islander Serving Institution.
- The AANAPISI program, is one of eight federally designated Minority Serving Institution (MSI) programs
- Established by Congress in 2007 as part of the College Cost Reduction and Access Act.
- Expanded in 2008 under the Higher Education Opportunity Act
- Title III Part A-Cooperative Grant



AANAPISI Cooperative Grant Berkeley City College & Laney College

- BCC (21%) & Laney (26%) College AAPI students
- Mentorship
- District-wide collaboration to support AAPI students \$2.5 Million Grant (\$500K/Year)

#### AAPI Healthy Transitions Project Goals

- Culturally responsive support services
- Expand mental health resources for AAPI students
- Professional development opportunities for faculty and staff
- Increase course completion rates of AAPI students, with special focus on Southeast Asian and Pacific Islander
- Provide guided support for AAPI students beginning in ESOL to transition to CTE certificate and degree programs
- Work-based learning opportunities for students
