Scaling Up Student Success for Underserved Communities in Higher Education Model is grounded on intensive interviews that represented 307 years of direct experience in working toward scaling up student success programs for students from underserved communities in higher education. This framework highlights elements of interventions that address the complex needs of students and involve collaborations between all segments of the education system, as well as partnerships between education and business.

The model is a practical guide for educators and educational leaders committed to student success and educational equity with a great potential to influence institutional policies and practices in community college and to revamp schools and colleges on a broad scale, across P-20 educational arenas and provides implications for more effective institutionalized and equitable educational practices.
