Student Rights and Responsibilities

Student Accessibility Services (SAS) Berkeley City College (BCC) Peralta Community College District (PCCD)

STUDENTS HAVE A RIGHT:

- 1. To participate voluntarily in SAS.
- To receive academic adjustments, auxiliary aids, services and/or instruction from SAS and *not be precluded* from participating from any other course, program or activity offered by the college.
- To have educational records and disability information protected from disclosure. (In order to provide services, SAS staff may have to communicate your educational needs to college employees who have a legitimate need to know. SAS follows <u>FERPA</u> guidelines regarding disclosure).
- 4. To appeal a decision regarding accommodations through the student grievance process as described in the college catalog.

STUDENT RESPONSIBLITIES ARE:

- 1. To comply with the student code of conducted as defined in the college catalog.
- To meet the academic standards established by the college (i.e., have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher and have less than 50% of "W", "I" or "NP" grades for all grades recorded), when enrolled in general classes.
- 3. To make measurable progress toward your course goals as agreed upon in the Academic Accommodation Plan (AAP), when taking educational assistance classes.
- 4. To be *responsible* in your use of SAS services and adhere to the program's Policy Guidelines for Services.
