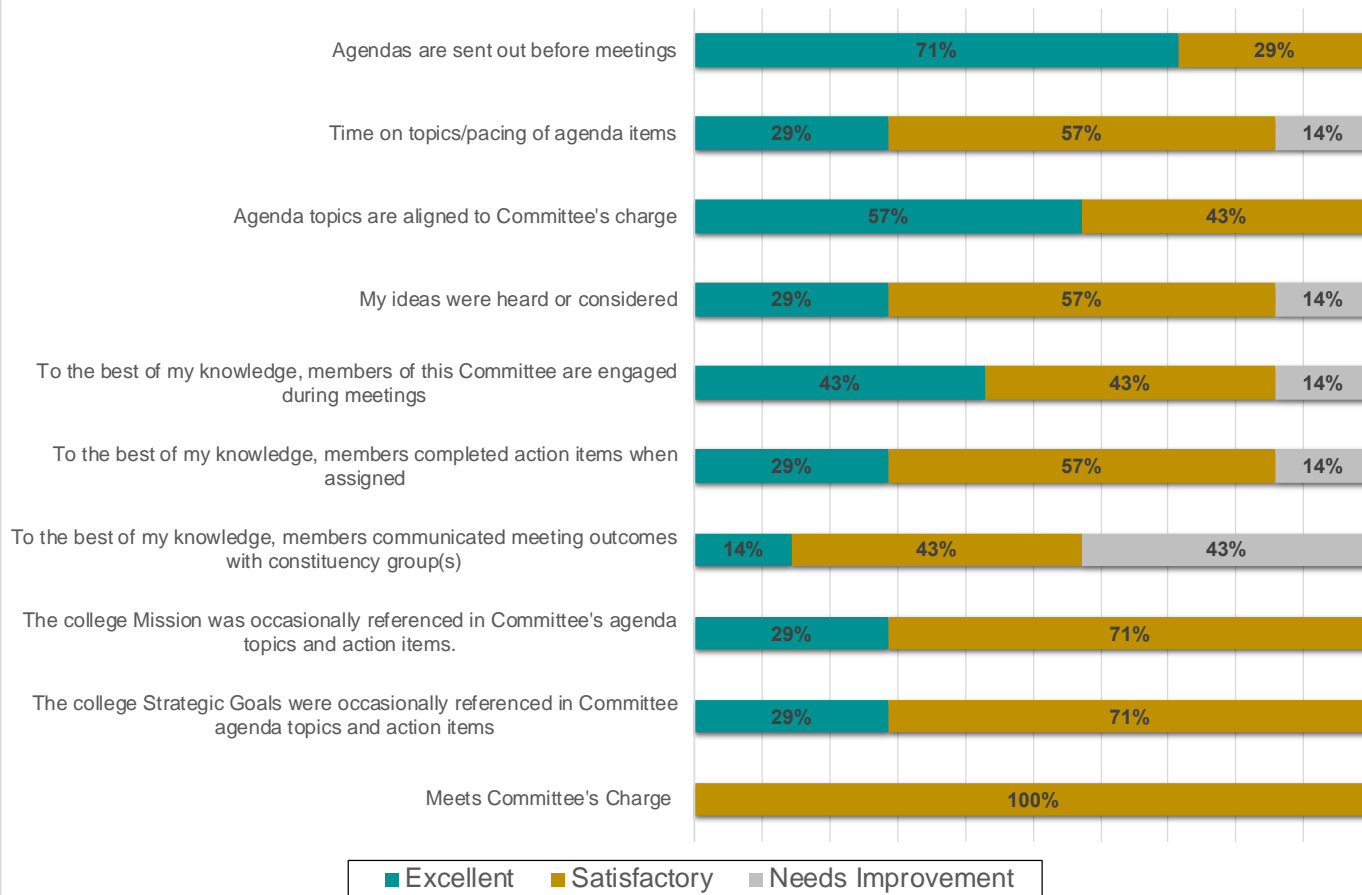
COLLEGE ROUNDTABLE COMMITTEE CHARGE

- Total of 7 respondents
- Mostly excellent & satisfactory ratings for all survey items

Strengths:

- Clear agendas and objectives
- Aligned to Mission and Goals
- Strong representation

Recommendations:

- Focus on objectives and their evaluations
- Need more time for budget planning
- Committee sharing needs to be more substantive
- More planning and less reporting
