## CCC Chancellor's Office- IEPI Support

- BCC submitted an IEPI Proposal on **March 27, 2022**
- All 4 PCCD Colleges and District Office submitted proposals
- **Peer Resource Team:** Team of CCC colleagues who review our proposal and offer expertise to implement necessary activities/process to meet our proposal goal.
- Upon completion of the IEPI process, **BCC will receive \$200k** to implement the plan of action after PRT visit #1 (October 31) and visit #2 (December 2)

## BCC Areas of Focus

### 1. Infrastructure Capacity Building for use of data focused on Equitable Student Outcomes

- Build capacity in the **IR Office** for increased data analysis and systems revisions
- Facilitate, guide, and support faculty and classified professionals to make **necessary programmatic and service revisions that lead to equitable outcomes** (e.g. , APU/CPR revisions, BPAs for Guided Pathways implementation)
- Identify, record, analyze, and **action plan to address students' experience of BCC** and key areas of challenges and institutional barriers that inhibit their progress
- Facilitate and support professional development for teaching & learning with faculty and classified professionals, including but not limited to **New Faculty Academy, Adjunct Faculty Symposium, Classified Professionals Symposium.**



## BCC Areas of Focus

### 2. Strengthen and streamline fiscal capacity to sustain institutional priorities focused on equitable student outcomes

- **Integrating equitable outcome data to strategic planning**, as it relates to strategic planning and overall institutional effectiveness
- Develop a **visual representation** of how equitable outcomes data are used in resource allocation.
