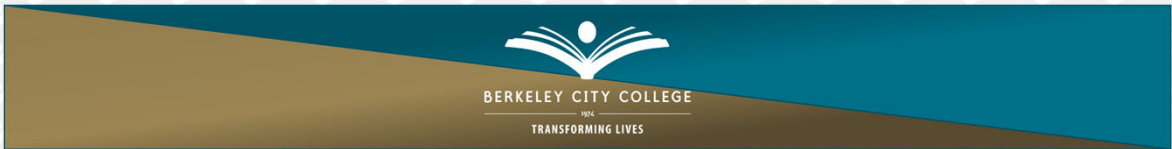

 - Requirement 1: overall financial oversight and controls
 - Requirement 2: Audit
 - Requirement 3: Financial Aid
 - Requirement 5,6,&7: Directly related Board issues



Accreditation Follow Up Report and Visit Update

- 3 Fiscal issues must be resolved by this January 2023 (This report and October team visit are critically important):
 - Requirement 1: Financial planning and stability
 - Requirement 2: Audit
 - Requirement 3: Restructuring

Positive progress made thus far.

Hope that this continued effort to mitigate requirements will get us to an reaffirmation of the Accreditation status.
