Committee updates:

Technology committee met Feb. 2nd - Good news - the Laptops are in the LRC for students to use - Vincent will be replacing the refurbished pc laptops with new once they arrive. 10 macs and 25 PC laptops in place - 3 high end PC laptops still in progress. - We learned that all technology refresh plans and classroom refresh and network upgrade have been sidelined until the new building is complete. Some funding has been identified to update lab 324 - it may be possible to purchase another 18 PC computers for that room - adding to the 10 PC computers purchased last year.
10 classroom project completed - money went over - feb board for amendment of payment.
Website got final funding - company moving forward - President Garcia helped make it happen. Australian company will be completing the templates - summer finalizing - serious redesign.
Timeline - 16-20 weeks from start. Will ask for some Winter Flex time to review. Student Panel will be included to check user experience before website design lock. Website helpdesk was moved to a second drop down menu under BCC IT - Tania will add to her email signature so folks will know where to find it.
Network is starting to fail - 17 years old. Ports are failing. Noticeable drop in performance. Additional ports on network switches are becoming defective. Therefore, reducing the quantity of network ports for connecting devices. As Technology updates have been sidelined no information on when this project will be green lit to be started. The techcommittee see this as the highest priority as the college cannot function without a network. District IT went through the shared governance process to garner support for the project again - it was an approved project prior to the pandemic. All colleges approved moving forward. it is still waiting approval for a green light and funding line to move forward.
