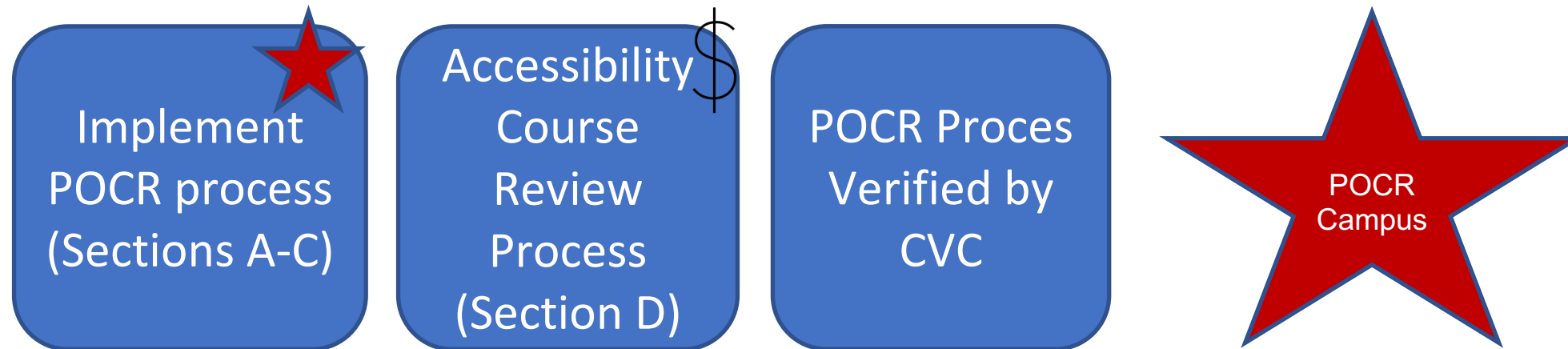
Benefits of Becoming a Teaching College

Accessibility

- Accessibility is Section D of the POCR rubric
- Accessibility is also a part of Title V, and section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973
 - Accommodations for individual students are handled through SAS address *section 504* of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.
 - Section 508 addresses the technological infrastructure that allows online accessibility
 - This is a highly technical aspect
- Accessibility is Equity
