Update & Preview from Professional Development (10 mins) Community care and Mental Health focus Flex Day addressed burnout. January Flex Day will be focused on community building. Will hold activities ON CAMPUS. Will also host it as a hybrid event. Beyond Flex Day, other activities are PD funding conference funding, one-time funding on POCR. Faculty can request up to \$1200 per year for PD. Sabbatical one applicant so far, for the 23-24 year. Working with Inger Stark on training for applying for PD funds. b. Resoution for Discussion on Adoption of Low-Cost Textbook Definition (10 mins) Want to set a low cost threshold. Want Peralta to do this so students can identify low cost classes. Laney has passed a \$50 threshold cost for Bay Area students. Merritt is going through processes to pass a threshold as well. It'd be great to reach consensus for Peralta so we can establish an icon within our schedule to ID classes that are deemed low cost. ASCCC endorsed \$30 from the student Senate resolution. Bay Area is expensive though. Laney noted that it is really hard to stay below \$30 even for lab manuals, buying low cost books. ASBCC endorsed the \$30 low cost threshold. Clemaus Tervalon (COA student) president@ssccc.org Faculty comments: use the spirit of the resolution to set a threshold for low cost rather than focus on the actual amount maybe go with lower amount so faculty strive to reach that amount.

		If faculty cannot meat the threshhold, then we do not deem it low cost. Low Cost icon is a District designation It's best to reach a district wide consensus on low cost. It seems district wide, \$50 is the consensus.
		Many faculty at BCC want to listen to the students. They want \$30.
		COA and Laney have passed Academic Senate resolutions for \$50.
		Do we have a sense of how many textbooks fall within that \$30 range? Do the options increase when we increase to \$50? We can ask the Bookstore about this.
