As a Senate we can take action and ask that this funding be prioritized over others such as high level VC positions, the new Professional Development Center at the District, and the hiring of consultants. We need to work with the DAS as well to put pressure on the District to fund various important positions.

Is this impacting other areas as well - how many other positions (release time) are currently being funded by the district?

		The DE Accessibility Specialist may not be hired until 2024-25 academic year. The DAS was informed that no funding has been allocated to the hiring of FT faculty in the coming year. We have two outstanding positions that were approved last year, and are still funded. We should go the Board Meeting to give statistics on POCR reviewed and badged courses. If we are not supporting accessibility, we are not supporting equity. Storm the public comments session at the BOT meetings. We are working on a resolution but it feels like making noise is more important. What is the reality to de-annex? We've tried once before. It's a great question. The first step is to get the Peralta Board to allow it; it was weird how we managed to get four Board members to approve it last time — not sure we could do it again.
