4. Discussion and/or Information	a. CC Update (10 mins) b. GP Update (10 mins)	a. Curriculum Committee Update (10 mins) New legislation has been passed - AB 928 CALGETC - Implementation Fall 2025

We have two pathways to transfer -- one for UC and one for CSU.
This legislation will combine to one pathway with CALGETC.

The CSU breadth requirements has Area E -- Lifelong Learnnig and Self Development. There are courses in that area that won't be in CALGETC.

Three classes specifically: Counseling 24 and 57 and Health 1. Perhaps we can put these courses into a program so we can continue to maintain enrollment.

Work on CALGETC at BCC will robustly start in Spring 2024.

For students who have already taken referenced courses or who have already passed them, will they have catalog rights to still transfer using these courses in 2025/2026? Yes, any courses approved now in IGETC will transfer at that time. They will have catalog rights. Courses just won't satisfy a GE requirement.

We've finalized the Academic and Career Academies. There are 6 of them.

We created first rounds of program maps for all AA and AA-T programs. These make pathways to graduation clear to students. They uncover hidden prerequisites. They do NOT replace conversations with counselors/faculty. Beta versions are going live soon.

Make an appointment with Catherine Nichols if you want to review your program maps. She's a one-person show, so please be patient with scheduling that time with Catherine.

We met with faculty leads and created student success tip sheets and program specific faculty tips for student success to include in maps.

We hosted focus groups with faculty to examine what elements each ACC should have. One thing that came out was to create an opportunity for faculty within each ACC to meet and collaborate.

	We ought to create a website audit to ensure consistency with program information to students across the board.
	Pilot/draft day is 10/27 for faculty. Hold ACC Booths. Other booths would include a Program Mapper Viewer and viewing the website mock-up (and provide comments).
	ACC Booths could offer: Job/Internship board, faculty profiles - how did you choose a major - what is your origin story. Cutting ede work in the field, career opportunities and trends, alumni spotlights, student games, transfer degree opportunities, etc.
	This is definitely a pilot event. It's an opportunity for faculty to collaborate on a project within their ACC and build community and identify ways to marshall resources.
