### Cal-GETC Who did this?

- Assembly bill 928, Student Transfer Achievement Reform Act of 2021 (Berman, 2021)
- Two parts
  - Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADT)
    - Establish ADT intersegmental Implementation Committee
    - Requires CCC's to place students on ADT Pathways (\$500,000 through PCCD apportionment)
  - Cal-GETC = Single general education pathway
- Cal-GETC History

### Cal-GETC What is Cal-GETC?

- Singular lower division general education (GE) pathway that meets the academic requirement necessary for transfer admission to the CSU and UC
- Current GE patterns
  - IGETC for UC and CSU
  - GE Breadth for CSU only
    - Area E: Lifelong Learning and Self-Develop will not be included in Cal-GETC
    - Impact on BCC Counseling courses
    - Impact on Modern Languages UC grad requirement

Area 5A: Physical Science- 1 course (3 semester or 4 quarter units) Area 5B: Biological Science- 1 course (3 semester or 4 quarter units) Area 5C: Laboratory- (1 semester or 1 quarter unit)	2 courses (7 semester or 9 quarter units)
Area 6 – Ethnic Studies	One course in ethnic studies or in a similar field provided that the course is cross-listed with ethnic studies.	1 course (3 semester or 4 quarter units)

- Create a singular pathway to both systems
- Ensure reduction in the number of excess units at CCC
- Eliminate repetition of courses at four-year universities taken by CCC students
- Increase the number of CCC Students who transfer

- Consultation has been completed with our Communications faculty
  - Established a timeline = Complete new Course Outline (COR) of Record to match the requirement for Area 1C.
    - Comm 3, Comm 4, Comm 20, Comm 45
  - COR will be completed at the end of spring 2024 for approval for the December 2024 Cal-GETC submission. Decisions are expected in May 2025.
