




ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. First generation college students
- 2. Qualified for financial aid (Cal Promise or Pell Grant)
- 3. Students planning to transfer to a 4-year university
- 4. Pursuing a calculus-based STEM major
- 5. Must be a US Citizen/Permanent Resident/AB-540





FRIENDS OF MESA

Students that don't meet the first gen or financial aid requirement are still able to participate in MESA.
