Applying Cognitive Theory to Math Pedagogy

Participants will be able to apply the most recent cognitive theory to the teaching of mathematics. According to the BCC Equity Report, African American and Latino students as well as students from low socio-economic backgrounds, students with disabilities, active military and veteran students, and students who have been or are currently in the foster care system are at high risk for failing or not completing their math classes at BCC. To address this equity issue, this workshop will introduce math instructors to current cognitive theories that align with how students learn mathematical concepts and will demonstrate how math instructors can apply these theories to develop effective math lessons.
