Purpose:

Reporting directly to the Roundtable, the Technology Committee serves the purpose of the shared governance decision-making process at BCC. The charge of the Committee is to advise the administration on technology issues regarding:

- <u>Access:</u> Provide secure computer and internet access to learning resources and support services by systematically plans, acquires, maintains, and upgrades or replaces technology and equipment to meet institutional needs.
- <u>Instructional Technology:</u> Support the success of all students through the development of instructional technologies, including the delivery of instructional media.
- <u>Campus Computing:</u> Improve technology systems to increase institutional efficiencies and provide long-term support for campus computing needs.
- <u>Network Infrastructure:</u> Upgrade and maintain the network infrastructure to support comprehensive wireless, voice, video, and data communications (shared with District).
- <u>Technology Support:</u> Provide ongoing training and technology support services to meet the needs of students, faculty, staff and managers.
- <u>Human and Fiscal Resources:</u> Develop, distribute and utilize resources to support the development, maintenance, and enhancement of its programs and services.
- <u>Business Continuity:</u> Ensure technology resources as sufficient to maintain uninterrupted business-critical operations.
