- Have CPR, First Aid, and AED certifications within 30 days of hire

Preferred Qualifications

- Be able to speak Spanish
- Have at least 1 year experience working with youth in a similar environment
- General knowledge of core elementary subjects - English, Math, Science, Social Science
- Have classroom and behavioral management skills
- Have knowledge of basic computer skills & functions (Zoom, Google Drive, etc.)
