

## **Seeking ASL-fluent nanny in Berkeley to help us care for our infant son**

Our 2-month old has profound hearing loss, and we would like to give him the best start possible. We're seeking a loving, experienced caregiver who can expose him to American Sign Language while the rest of the family gets up to speed on signing.



**We need an individual with M-F daytime availability, 30-40 hours, to assist in general caretaking while using ASL consistently.**

Applicants must be affectionate, comfortable caring for an infant, willing to read lots of books, and play and sign with him extensively. Car access is not necessary, as we live in South Berkeley within a few blocks of a large park and library. Besides hearing loss, Oscar has no other special needs. Dad will be available part-time in-home, and will handle all doctor's visits or other extended outings.

Note that this is a childcare, not tutoring, position. The rest of the family (Mom, Dad and 3-year-old brother) are hearing, but we will be learning ASL simultaneously elsewhere.

We welcome Deaf or hard of hearing applicants.
